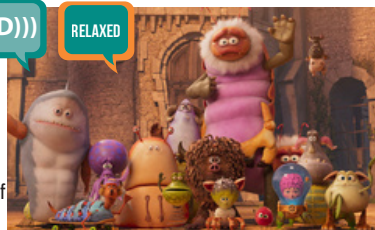

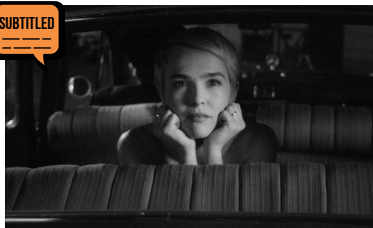
NOUVELLE VAGUE (12A)
