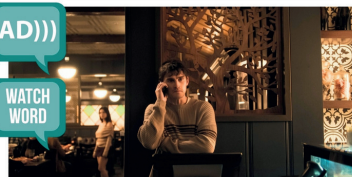

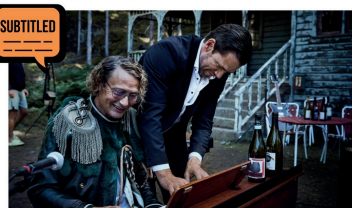
THE LAST VIKING (15)

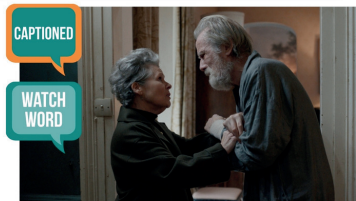
